



Audition Information for SINGERS

Your audition will take place at the Asper Jewish Community Campus, located at 123 Doncaster Street in the Gray Academy Music Room #A132. Enter through the main doors of the Campus and pass through the Security Desk. You may be asked to show identification. Once through security, turn left and go down the main hall, past the restaurant and past the pool. Keep going straight and go through the set of doors. The music room will be the first room on the right.

Please note the following:

- Be prepared to sing two pieces - one up-tempo and one down-tempo.
- One piece should be in English (musical theatre preferred) and one in Hebrew or any other foreign language.
- You may sing a cappella or you provide your own karaoke accompaniment. A Bluetooth speaker will be at your disposal should wish to sing along to an instrumental track.
- Along with the harmony assessment, you may also be asked to perform a range test that our Vocal Director will guide you through.

During your audition we will be looking for accurate musicianship as well as how well you tell the story of your songs - performance is just as important as pitch. You may be asked to complete a harmony exercise, as much of what we do is based on choral singing.

You will be informed of the results of your audition via email or regular mail. This will typically arrive within a week of the audition, and will detail either the conditions of your acceptance into Chai or specific recommended areas of training should we feel you would benefit from further growth before being accepted into the group.
